6x round headed clips



scissors



String



glue



cardboard  
(not too thick)

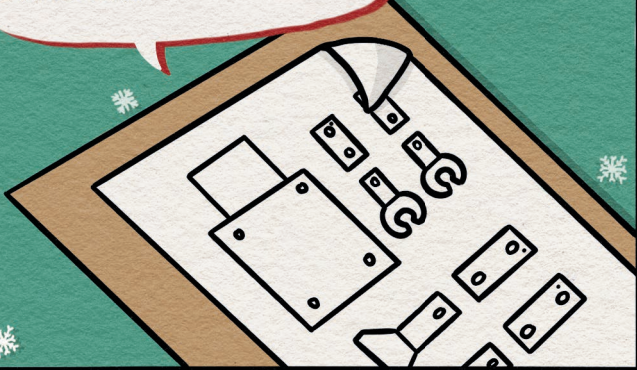
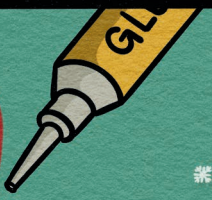

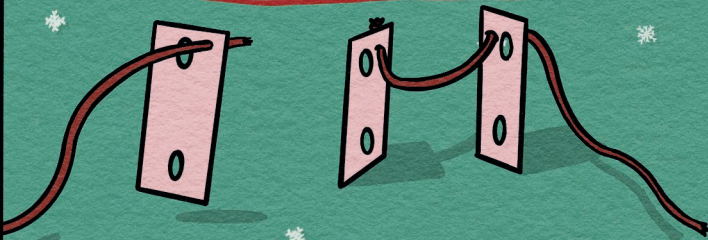
Oh hey! Thanks for sticking me on cardboard. That's way better. Now, could you please paint me a face and cut me out?



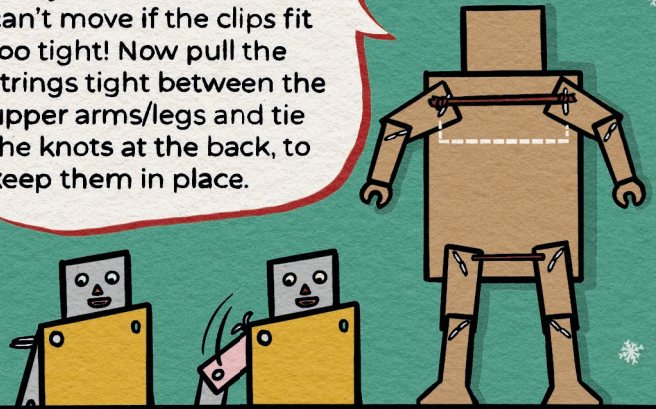
Wow, I like that look! See these little marked holes? It'd be robotastic if you could cut them out. At first, take something sharp (like scissors, careful now!) to stab through the holes. Pay attention to the different sizes though, there are small and big holes!



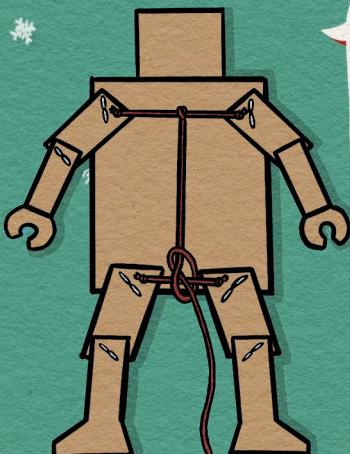
Now we need some string, so I can move my limbs. Thread it through the small hole, starting from the painted side of my arm/leg. Tie a knot at the back. If you cut the string, make sure you leave plenty of length. You now need to thread it through my other arm/leg, same way as before, starting from the painted side. But don't tie the second knot just yet!



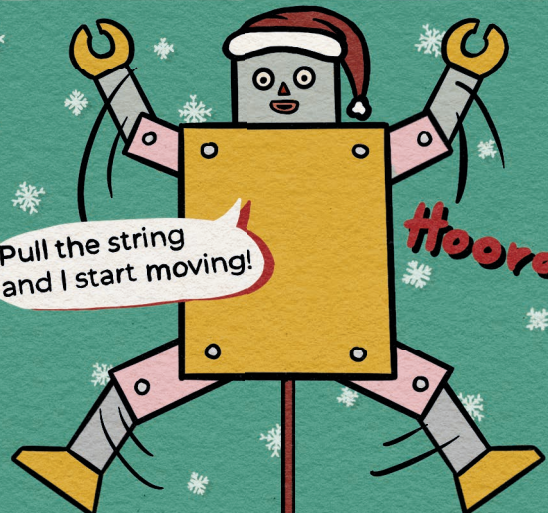
Using the round-headed clips, assemble my arms and legs and attach them to my torso. But careful, I can't move if the clips fit too tight! Now pull the strings tight between the upper arms/legs and tie the knots at the back, to keep them in place.



Great job! We almost made it! To complete me, we need one more piece of string. Knot it in the middle of the string between my arms and legs, starting with my arms. You need to leave plenty of string hanging down.



Pull the string and I start moving!
